Some fail to get off in disbelief that this could possibly be our main train station. Give it some time – it's a work in progress.





Inside the foyer of our beautiful functionalist library hides a little design shop just waiting to be discovered. A small one, but ours. It only features the products of our local designers, which is no surprise in a city where the local university runs several Design programs. Jewels, socks, brooches, backpacks, fashion or decoration? Could make for a good souvenir from Zlín!



A short walk from the bus station, hidden inside one of Zlín's iconic buildings—the former shoemaking factory. Toyen, Kubišta and Mucha are just some of the names of prominent Czech artists whose works are on display here. If contemporary art is not your BFF, you might prefer the section about Zlín's design and architecture.

Immerse yourselves in the history of Zlín, Baťa's empire and southeast Moravia. The museum, inside the same building as the regional gallery, lets you revisit times long past. Exhibits include the world's smallest shoes as well as shoes so big a toddler could nap in them, dried-out skulls of literal headhunters and replicas of workshops that used to stand all around.



A very stylish industrial-style café right next to the city museum and gallery encourages every artistic soul. Offline world lovers enjoy the hot chocolate, concerts, exhibitions or talks that happen here every now and then.



A lunch-only affair in the heart of the industrial Svit complex. One of the few vegetarian, sometimes even vegan and gluten-free friendly restaurants we go to if we want to feel good about what food we put in our bodies. You can take what you want, paying for the total weight of your plate. You might appreciate their ISIC discount and reduced prices starting at 15. To avoid busy hours, come after 13.



The best bar in Zlín known for its infamous parties that you will both never forget and not remember the next day. A wide selection of drinks, electronic music and nice interior will make you party like you're 18 again. In the summer, all this moves to a spot under the stars in the center of the industrial part of the city.



Wandering through Svit? Don't forget to check out Kabinet T. The gallery can be found in a basement underneath the grocery store ENAPO and you can expect to see visual works of art made by contemporary Czech and foreign authors. A must-see for all the art freaks out there!



As soon as summer kicks in, Zlíners flock to the nearest body of water to escape from the scorched brick jungle that is Zlín. Despite its somewhat questionable reputation (urban legends have it that many a cadaver, including one of a horse, have graced the surface of the water), the flooded former gravel quarry in Otrokovice is a popular spot. Paddleboards are for rent here and in the local snack bar you can order the holy trinity of Czech summer — a beer, a hot dog and a popsicle. What else can one need?

Do you really want to experience Zlin architecture? Then head to Letná for a walk. If you're lucky, the Bafa era housing infopoint will be open. Inside you will get a feel of what living inside a typical Bafa house was like during the golden age. Or you can just ring the bells of random little houses on the way and beg the inhabitants to let you come in for a custom visit. (Don't) Local tip: Right next to the shop—the only one in all of Letná—you'll find an out-of-place American-style wooden house, which Bafa originally tested as a possible model for construction in the city.



TRAIL OF HEALTH

Got a free afternoon and feel like taking a stroll? Great. Let's start by checking out a couple of Ba'a houses, then jump into the woods and onto the Trail of Health (Stezka zdravi), which will lead you through the forest all the way to Malenovice Castle. If you need some motivating, just keep in mind that under the castle you will find our most beloved brewery alongside a little pub. This is where the magic of Zlínský Švec happens. (Don't be shy and chug a fresh half-dark eleven degree.) With the trolleybus back from Malenovice, you'll be home in a guarter of an hour.

57 CEMETERY IN THE WOODS



If you could pick a place for your eternal rest, come consider this beautiful spot. No, it isn't weird at all. Yes, we really come here just to hang out. And if you still find it a bit odd, just pretend you are passing through and heading to the nearby Forest Hotel – they cook very well! And yep, that's a hotel next to a cemetery.


You can easily spend a whole afternoon here if you want. Ride all the way to Kudlov (bus no. 32). Set a bit aside, you'll find it is not the liveliest of places, but you will come across luxurious mansions and a functionalist chapel. You can take a walk to the nearby film studios, which in their best years garnered a lot of fame, mainly for their movies for children. Nowadays, the studios are home to an art school and an exhibition called Filmový Uzel about the film studio's history and its greatest creators. On your way back to the center, do not miss Bistro Kudlov, which is becoming a popular Sunday pit stop for its fresh Czech desserts and sous-vide pulled pork.



Shopping



Regular stores, including the beloved bakeries, mostly close at 18, while on weekends they usually only stay open on Saturday mornings. Supermarkets are open until 21 on weekdays and weekends. We are not big on non-stop shops in the center, but the little window at the bus station will satisfy all your unhealthy shopping needs on a late night.



Public transport

If you want to catch a ride on a trolleybus or a bus, remember that after midnight you won't have much luck. They resume regular operation at around 4 in the morning.

Tip: When traveling to Zlín by train, you will most likely have to change in Otrokovice. Don't waste time waiting on your connection to Zlín and take the trolleybus no. 2 and 6 or bus no. 70 to the city center instead. All for just 15 crowns.

Taxi, please!

If the trolleybus lets you down, a taxi will have your back. You won't spend a fortune on it either — a ride inside the city does not usually go over 100 crowns. If there are more of you, you might end up paying the same as you would for a trolleybus.

Mondays are cultural no-go days

If you want to check out a museum or a gallery, don't leave it for a Monday. Places of culture in the entire country tend to stay closed on this day of the week.



Alcohol & cigarettes

You'll buy them virtually anywhere. Watch out – it is not allowed to drink in public in Zlín. The Czech government has also banned smoking inside all places of business (including restaurants and bars) as well as all stations and bus stops.

THE BATA **PHENOMENON**

The etymology of the name Zlín has had various interpretations in the local folk tradition. One possible explanation is that the city was afflicted by a series of unfortunate events; hence the name was derived from the Czech word for bad (zlý). Others associate it with the word slín (Czech for a kind of claymarl), as clay soil is abundant in the area.

Thanks to this factory owner, a small village bearing the name Zlaté Jablko (Golden Apple) was transformed beyond recognition. Tomáš Baťa Senior founded his factory here in 1894 and in the coming vears. Zlín was born and the success of Bata's company completely determined the look of the emerging city.

When the city's father Tomáš Baťa was suddenly killed in an airplane accident, it didn't take even a year to build his memorial, which you can now marvel at as it overlooks Gahurův Prospekt in the very center of Zlín. The inside of this functionalist concrete and glass jewel is nothing but pure space, sharp angles and a monumental replica of the fateful Junkers F13 monoplane.

Have you heard of a very Czech touristic dining habit that is roasting *špekáčky* (short and chubby sausages) on an open fire? We do not know a single person that does not enjoy this, vegetarians included. One of the destinations for all avid sausage roasters is at the summit of our magnificent ski slope, known simply as Svah. Here you can start a decent fire while basking in a precious view of Zlín. All of Zlín will be at your feet and so will the "toilets" in the nearby forest.



Once upon a time, there was a small bistro at the verge of Kudlov Forest where passers-by would bend over backwards to get their hands on some delicious pulled pork, goulash, beer specials and cream rolls so crisp it brought even the bravest men to tears. But seriously, this place is worth every single step you have to take to get there. Just make sure they are open!

And if they want to eat away their feelings or just really need a hearty breakfast, they stay faithful to Zlínský Kafec 57.



PARK & CHILL ZLÍNER

Park & Chill Zlíners have figured out that Komenského Park is the ideal summer location to chill without ever having to leave. All their needs are taken care of — they stuff their faces with burgers from Bürger 22 (try a Zluty!), quench their thirst with lemonades and beer from the adjacent Pstros 21 and order coffee straight into their laps, courtesy of the mobile Coffee Express. Just drop a blanket, put up a slackline and achieve nirvana.



FOODIE ZLÍNER

This type of Zlíner knows that the early bird gets delicious pancakes from Bistrotéka 15 for breakfast, for lunch they get a taste of India at Makalu 12 across the street and their dinner is an Italian job at Pizzeria Umbrella 20. Here's to hoping they don't fall into a food coma!



BEER ZLÍNER

True fans of the golden nectar are regulars at Zelenáčova Šopa 390, where they sip on a pint of Zlínský Švec to make an informed decision on our local lager. For more traditional beer culture in the form of a properly-chilled Pilsner Urquell, they stop at U Kovárny 400 close by. And if they bring along a group of buddies, they pop into U Máců 450.
