01 MOST CURIOS FLEA MARKET ☹
SUNDAY + SUNDAY / EARLY MORNING - NOON

HOW TO GET AROUND

The yellow "BREMERHAVEN BUS" buses will take you everywhere. Once arrived at the central station and looking for the city center, it is best to take one of the following lines heading north: 502 | 504 | 505 | 506 | 508 | 509 | HL.

Get off at "Grote Kirche" or "Havenwelten".
TIP: The "Fairflanner" app (VSN) helps you find the best connection and book tickets.

Alternatively, you can explore Bremerhaven by **BIKE** or on **FOOT**. If you ever get lost, this will help you find your way around. The city is long and narrow. On the left is the water. On the right is the A27 highway. In the center there is a radar tower, a church and a hotel that looks like a sail.

TIP: Don't ride your bike in the pedestrian zone. As the name suggests, this is an area reserved for pedestrians. If you ride your bike here, not only will you be unpopular, but even worse, you could get a fine.

WIFI

Be prepared. **FREE WIFI** is still scarce here. But take this as an opportunity for a few days of digital detox. However, in some cafes and buses, it shouldn't be a problem.

CASH/EC (DEBIT CARD)

It's best to always have some cash on you. Smaller shops, restaurants, buses, taxis and weekly markets do not accept EC card payments. ATMs are available throughout the city.

OPENING HOURS

Most retailers are open until 6/7 pm. Supermarkets are often open until 9/10 pm. On **SUNDAYS**, shops are closed in Bremerhaven (and almost all over Germany). Cultural attractions, such as museums, cinemas, theaters are usually open on this day as well.

TIP: Many gas stations are open around the clock and you can still get ketchup for your fries after 3 am at the 24-hour EDEKA. **63**

5 MINUTES OF HISTORY

1827

JOHANN SMID, the mayor of Bremen at that time, buys a piece of land from the Hanover Kingdom in order to make more space for port operations.

1830

After **MASS EMIGRATION** of more than 7 million Europeans via Bremerhaven to overseas, the city experienced a boom. An urban settlement spread next to the port.

1944

On the 18th of September the city was bombed by the Allies. Today's **Mitte** and **Geestmünde** districts were almost completely destroyed in the attack within only 20 minutes. This is one of the reasons why there is no real **HISTORIC OLD TOWN** in the city center. Since the Goethezeit in **Lehe** and **Alte Bürger** in **Mitte-Nord** were spared from the attack, there are still numerous **GRÜNDERZEIT HOUSES** in this area.

1945

After World War II, Bremerhaven became an enclave of the **AMERICAN OCCUPATION** zone on Northern Germany. The USA needed a supply port in this reason, you will come across American features in various places in the city.

1959

The first German **FISH FINGERS** were produced in a Bremerhaven fish factory.

1970

The fishing and shipbuilding industry experienced an economic slump.

1986

1990, 1995, 2000, 2005, 2008, 2010, 2015, 2020. The first **SAIL** took place in Bremerhaven and has long since become an international event. It is one of the largest windjammer gatherings in Europe and the world.

1993

US soldiers withdrew from Bremerhaven.

2000

STREET, SHOPPING CENTERS AND SHOPS WERE NAMED AFTER THEM. THE FOLLOWING IS A SHORT TOWN OF THE "STATS OF BREMERHAVEN".

JOHANN SMIDT
He was the **FOUNDER** of Bremerhaven. Bürgermeister-Smidt-Strasse in the Mitte district was named after him. Yet, the district was never mayor of Bremerhaven, but mayor of Bremen.

CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS
His landing in America in 1492, after getting lost with his sailing ship, earned Christopher Columbus the honor of having a street, ship, wharf, cruise terminal and a shopping mall (with a statue of him in front) dedicated to him.

LALLE ANDERSEN
Born in Bremerhaven, Lalle Andersen became an international celebrity in 1939 with the song "Lili Marleen". The song about young love at the lamp post in front of the barracks spread a bit of hope, especially to American soldiers. The Lalle Andersen **LAMTEN** is located on the corner of Lüthestrabe and Heisterstraße.

ELVIS PRESLEY
On October 1, 1958, the "King of Rock'n Roll" set foot on **EUROPEAN SOIL** for the first time - in Bremerhaven. Although he only stayed for a few minutes before continuing his journey, he remains an integral part of Bremerhaven's identity to this day.

HEIN WÜCK
A jolly sailor of the days of the sailing ships, who has become the **CITY ICON**. Look out for the brightly painted Hein. Music sculptures set up in front of or on top of some buildings.
