From here, there is a stair that goes directly down to the Botanical Garden (\bigcirc) to finish the hike with a walk through fountains and waterfall and you will see some stairs where you have to go up, then pass through sometimes we cannot see the cars coming. Continue to follow the path will follow to go down. At the end you have to cross a road, be careful continue to the East and you will find a nice path, with stairs that you towards the East. Follow the trail towards Mtatsminda park ($oldsymbol{B}$), where the big wheel and the TV tower are located. Once you reach the park,
